Moving through learning spaces inappropriately	Playing with balls or sports equipment (skipping ropes) unsafely	Swearing
Bringing expensive toys / equipment or war games to school	Calling people names; Insulting people; Teasing	Computer misuse / unsafe behaviours / wilful damage
Playing in out of bounds areas	Telling lies	Hiding during class
Not taking turns / pushing in	Urinating outside of the toilets	Hiding outside after the come in bell
Physically picking each other up	Arguing / raised voice to staff member	Destruction of the work or property of others
Repeatedly moving around and speaking loudly during eating time	Unruly behaviour in learning areas, walkways and on leaving the school	Refusing to comply with staff directions
Mistreating school property, e.g. graffiti on books, rulers etc	Working unsafely; using equipment in a dangerous manner	Leaving the school grounds without permission
Writing on hands, body parts whilst at school	Note writing / note passing	Talking to strangers
Distracting behaviours during class time; Not using class time effectively	Unsafe playing with sticks	Fighting, biting, hitting, punching, kicking, spitting
Leaving work space / classroom untidy – not packing up after yourself	Running inside	Inappropriate touching of others
Patting dogs / animals unless under staff supervision	Destruction of own work or property	Throwing sand, stones, objects at others
Imposing on other people's personal space	Not abiding by bus rules	Stealing
Sitting / lying on tables	Spitting	Starting rumours, Repeating rumours
